## What to bring to camp

Please bring lunch and a water bottle everyday. We have a refrigerator so there is no need for ice packs. Every child must wear an ASTM (American Society for Testing and Material Standard F1163-04a/SEI Certified) approved riding helmet. If your child does not have an approved riding helmet we will provide one. Please understand that the helmets we provide will be worn by others, but we will provide disposable liners to wear underneath the helmet. **Bike helmets are not acceptable for horseback riding.** Jeans or long pants are required for riding only. Paddock boots are recommended for riding or a boot with a heel and no buckles.

Please do not send children in good clothing. They will be getting dirty and most likely will be stepping in horse, chicken, and cow manure. Rubber rain boots are great and recommended for bathing cows and horses. Please bring a change of clothes, a bathing suit, and a towel. Please put sunscreen on your child before bringing them to farm camp.
